
Instructions

- You may remove band-aid or dressing from biopsy site in 24 hrs. Leave open to air. You may shower, clean with soap and water.
- Monitor site daily for any redness, drainage, bleeding, irritation, signs of infection, or if you have a fever above 101 degrees Fahrenheit seek medical attention.
- You may have minimal pain or discomfort at the site. If you are able to take Tylenol, take as indicated by the instructions. You may also apply cold compresses to area as needed.
- If you experience significant pain, please contact your primary care physician or seek medical attention.
- You may have an odd "sensation" when swallowing. This is also likely related to the procedure due to the local anesthetic/numbing agent used. This will wear off in a few hours.
- If you have difficulty swallowing, feel as if food/water will not go down, or if your throat feels tight in any way, this is a serious (and very rare) complication and will require you to immediately call 911.
